- understand and conceptualise the composition of the Government-wide monitoring and evaluation framework and intended outcomes,
- understand key monitoring and evaluation concepts and principles in the government context,
- understand the relationship between institutional monitoring and evaluation and the GWME system,
- understand and apply techniques for statistical and data analysis (analyse & interpret data),
- understand data collection and data analysis to specific indicators for monitoring and evaluation plan,
- understand the roles and responsibilities of government officials as implementing agents of monitoring and evaluation, and
- present the findings and recommendations of a monitoring and evaluation project or plan.
