The **Prevention and Detection of Corruption and Procurement Fraud** short course provides you with the requisite knowledge and skills to identify fraud and corruption, and to put mechanisms in place to prevent it from occurring, in the procurement and contracting of goods and services. The course aims to provide you with insights to procurement and contract fraud in a range of industries and the varying levels at which it occurs. You will also be able to familiarise yourself with the various applicable legal principles and definitions, while knowing which proactive preventive measures to implement when the red flags are raised.

This **credit-bearing course*** provides you with an entry point to formal degree programmes exclusively presented by the University of Pretoria with credits afforded towards the specified degree modules **FRA709 (20 credits)**.

- detect red flags that might be indicative of fraud and corruption in procurement and contracting processes; and
- advise on effective proactive preventive measures aimed at limiting fraud and related offences.

Who should enrol?

Procurement officials, as well as officials who have regular interaction with procurement, such as persons in finances, legal services, contract administration, support services and internal audit, and fraud examiners.

Admission requirements
