## Admission requirements

The course has no prerequisites but eligibility to write the exam and gain certification is strictly prescribed. The prerequisites to becoming PMP® certified are:

- A bachelor's degree, 4 500 hours project management experience and 35 hours of project management education (PPM or equivalent), or
- A Grade 12 certificate or the global equivalent, 7 500 hours project management experience and 35 hours of project management education (PPM, APPM or equivalent).

Delegates are advised to book an exam date 1–2 months after the workshop. This must be done through the PMI at [www.pmi.org](http://www.pmi.org).
