

# Mediation in Practice

The 40 hours **Mediation in Practice course** provides mediators with the requisite skills of being a mediator. A mediator clothed with the requisite 40 hours of training will be termed as an accredited mediator. The programme is dynamic and fun and allows the candidate to role-play complex legal problems and solve these issues by applying the skills that they have acquired in the programme.

The rules of the court, provide for accredited mediators that are endorsed by the government if they complete the 40 hours training from a University or Institution.

**The programme duration is 16 weeks.**
